

# Symbaloo.com

Social bookmarking. Save and share links. Example from SGS Library: <http://www.symbaloo.com/mix/sgslibrary>

Go to symbaloo.com. Can create free account and set symbaloo as homepage on your classroom devices. I created my teacher account using my school email address and made a “generic” library email account at yahoo to create my student symbaloo account. However, if you prefer, you can create a student webmix (page of links) as a tab under your teacher account and share just the student webmix page. Another use: you could make a webmix with links to online student projects such as Google Docs, Slide presentations, etc.
